Day 1: Paris — Honfleur — Beuvron en Auge — Deauville — Cabourg (306 kilometres)

Arrive in Paris and depart by private mini-coach to Honfleur. A walking tour will introduce you to this lovely harbour town. In the afternoon, drive to Beuvron en Auge and visit the Haras de Sens, where racing horses are bred, followed by cider-tasting. Continue to Deauville, for an exciting evening at the casino. Overnight in Cabourg.

Day 2: Cabourg — Bayeux — D-Day Beaches — Mont St Michel (225 kilometres)

Start the morning with a visit to Deauville, venue of the annual American film festival, followed by a romantic walk along the beautiful beaches. Your exploration continues to Bayeux famous for its tapestry, Arromanches to see the World War II D-Day Landing Beaches and the American military cemetery of Colleville, before driving to Mont St Michel. Overnight in Mont St Michel.

Day 3: Mont St Michel — St Malo — Rennes — Mont St Michel (127 kilometres)

In the morning, visit Mont St Michel, the most dramatic ecclesiastical building in France, before continuing along the coast to St Malo, a historic fortified

town and Rennes with its mediaeval quarter. Return to Mont St Michel for your overnight stay.

Day 4: Mont St Michel — St Brieuc — Cap Fréhel — Dinard — Mont St Michel (261 kilometres)

Today's drive takes you via the ancient town of St Brieuc and its magnificent cathedral, to the wild coast of Brittany at Cap Fréhel, with its 24 kilometres of pink cliffs and fine sandy beaches. After lunch you return to Mont St Michel via the seaside resort of Dinard for an afternoon on the beach. Overnight in Mont St Michel.

Day 5: Mont St Michel — Paris (358 kilometres)

In the morning we drive to Paris where there will be time for some sightseeing before you transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

Total distance: 1,277 kilometres.

Day 1: Paris — Blois — Chambord — Blois (224 kilometres)

Arrive in Paris. Travel by private mini-coach to Blois. After a walk round the old city, visit the colossal 444-room renaissance Château Chambord, one of the most impressive in the Loire Valley. Return to Blois for your overnight stay. Note: Some visits may not be possible due to the arrival schedule.

Day 2: Blois — Chenonceaux — Cheverny — Tours (179 kilometres)

After breakfast drive to Chenonceaux, a delicate renaissance château on the River Cher. There is free time for lunch before visiting the magnificently-furnished Cheverny Castle, built in pure Louis XIII style, distinguished by its extraordinary symmetry. Arrive in Tours for your overnight stay.

Day 3: Tours — Azay Le Rideau — Saumur — Tours (176 kilometres)

Your journey continues to Azay Le Rideau, a graceful 16th-century castle and one of the first to be built in the renaissance style. Free time for lunch before driving to Saumur where you see the mediaeval castle, explore the city and visit the Ecole Nationale d'Equitation, the renowned riding academy. Overnight in Tours.

Day 4: Tours — Fontevraud Abbey — Ussé — Tours (138 kilometres)

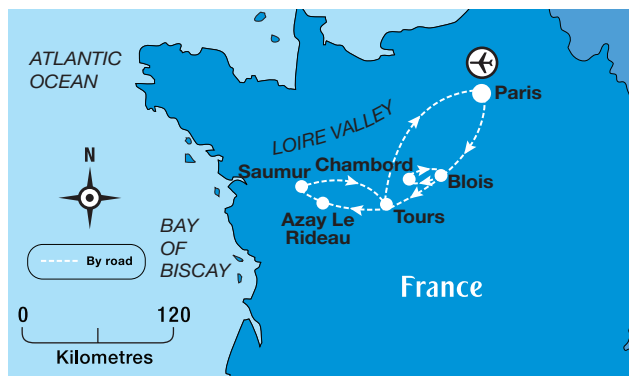
Start the morning by heading, via Chinon on the banks of the Vienne River, to the Romanesque Fontevraud Abbey. After lunch visit the 11th-century Castle of Ussé with its magnificent tapestries, and Loches Castle, built on a rocky outcrop overlooking the town. Overnight in Tours.



Day 5: Tours — Chartres — Paris (232 kilometres)

You return to Paris via Chartres for a visit to Notre Dame Cathedral – with its magnificent mediaeval stained-glass windows and superb stone carvings, it is one of the finest examples of Gothic architecture in Europe. After lunch and a short walk through the old town, you return to Paris where there is time for some sightseeing before your departure flight.

Total distance: 949 kilometres.



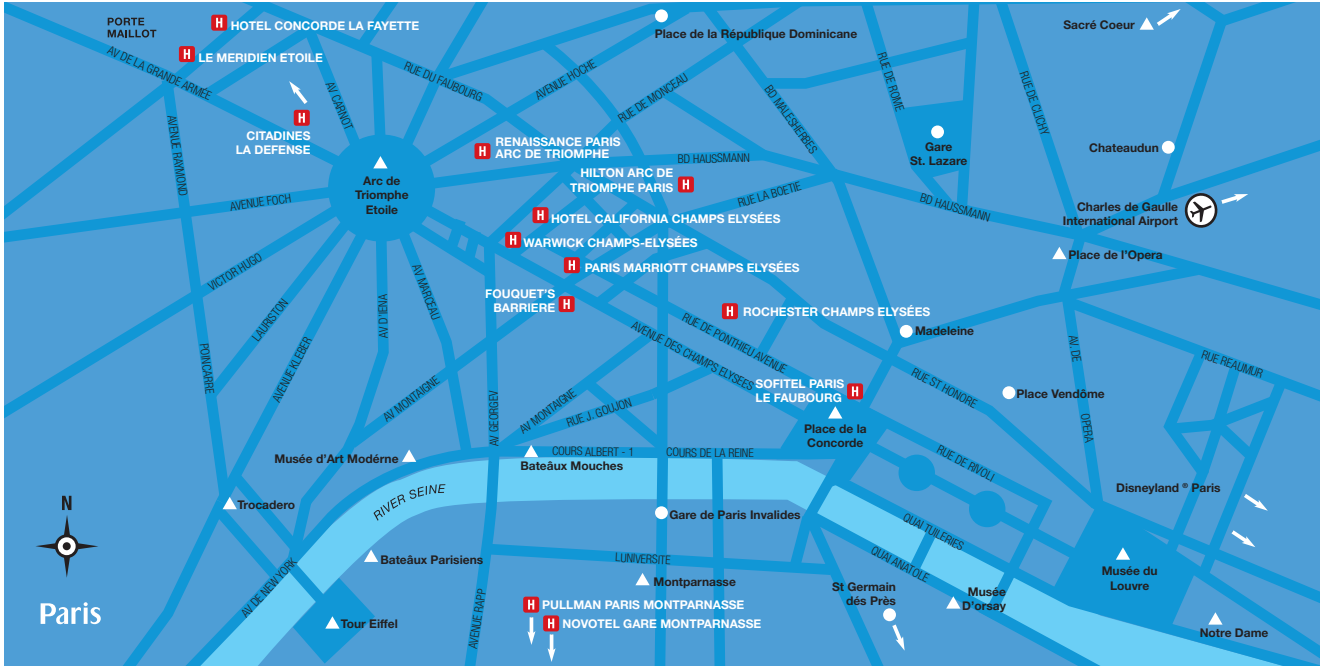

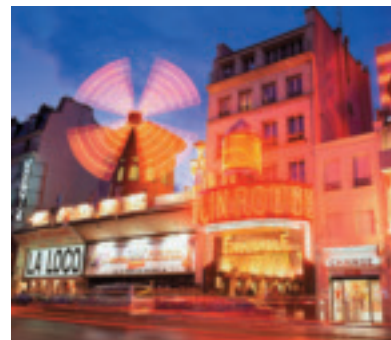

Paris and Versailles

Full-day coach excursion

This excursion is the ideal introduction to this enthralling city. We start where Paris itself started, on the **Ile de la Cité**, where **Notre Dame** stands, one of the most magnificent examples of Gothic ecclesiastical architecture in all of France, before heading into the trendy **Marais district**, which still retains its pre-revolutionary architecture.



We then visit the **Latin Quarter**, home to a lively mix of shops and restaurants. See the **Basilica de Sacré Coeur**, with its white Byzantine cupolas. Discover picturesque **Montmartre**, the city's traditional entertainment quarter, symbolised by the windmill sails of the **Moulin Rouge**. We then move on to visit the **Louvre**, the largest museum in the world. The museum's vast collection contains treasures such as the **Mona Lisa** and the **Venus de Milo**.

From there we go to the **Palace of Versailles**, the most beautiful of all France's chateaux. Although no longer used as a royal residence it still retains its glory. Accompanied by your driver-guide, you will see the magnificent park and the **Grand Trianon**. Inside, with the aid of an audio guide, you will see the **State Apartments**, including the glorious **Hall of Mirrors** and the **King and Queen's Apartments**.

This excursion operates daily except for Mondays and includes pick-up and drop-off at your hotel, entrance fees and English-speaking guide.
