Muir Woods & Sausalito

Half-day seat-in-coach excursion

This tour takes you from busy San Francisco across the Golden Gate Bridge and through the gentle countryside and along the rock-strewn coast of rural Marin County. Most of the giant redwood trees - some of the oldest and tallest trees on earth that once covered the area were chopped down to build San Francisco's Victorian houses, However, one towering grove still remains at Muir Woods. This is the only surviving primordial redwood forest; a tranquil place where sunlight filters 100 metres down through the canopy of 1,000-yearold trees to the laurel and ferncovered canyon floor below.
